**CIRCULAR**

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-rule 7 of Rule 3.3.4 of Food Safety and Standard Rules 2011; Presiding Officer of the Food Safety Appellate Tribunal Jaipur Rajasthan hereby issue following directions for the effective functioning of the tribunal. These directions are in addition to the provisions of Food Safety and Standard Rules 2011.

**I. Presentation of Appeal.-**


1. First page of the Memorandum of Appeal in prescribed ~~Form~~ shall be submitted online after depositing requisite fee for presentation of Appeal.
2. Form is available on <http://fsat-raj.in>
3. A party desirous of presenting an Appeal shall also pay the transaction charges in addition to the requisite fee for Appeal.
4. Online form can be filled by the party. In that case, only transaction charges of Rs.5/- for deposit of requisite fee are leviable.
5. A party may also take the services of e-Mitra in Rajasthan for this purpose. In that case, transaction charges e-Mitra Kiosks will be -  
(i) Rs.35/- if amount of requisite fee is less than Rs.2000/-;  
(ii)Rs.40/- if amount of requisite fee is more than Rs.2000/- but less than Rs.10,000/-
6. After filing the requisite information in the prescribed form of Appeal and deposit of fee, form should be submitted online. Party will take a print of the same. Copy of such print shall be presented along with the hard copy of the Appeal for verification.
7. Hard copy of the Appeal may be presented during time prescribed under the Food Safety and Standard Rules 2011, or may be send through speed post.
8. After submitting form for Appeal online, a party should present/ send hard copy of the Appeal within 10 working days to the Registrar, Food Safety Appellate Tribunal, Room No.28, Swasthya Bhawan, Tilak Marg, C-Scheme, Jaipur-302005, Rajasthan.
9. Online submission of Appeal shall be deemed to be presentation of Appeal for purpose of limitation.

**IV. Court dress for lawyers.—**

The following distinctive costume shall be worn by Advocates:-

Black Coat (Buttoned up or of open collar) or black achkan with bands; with a white shirt and white/black/grey/black and gray striped trousers and with the black achkan, a white churidar payjama shall be worn.

The lady Advocates shall wear a white saree without border or with sober border with white Blouse or white Salwar Kurta alongwith open neck or open collar or buttoned up black coat with white bands.
